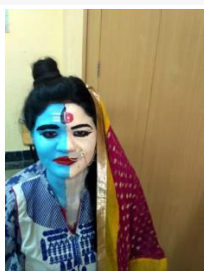

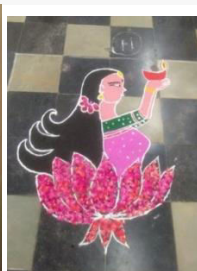

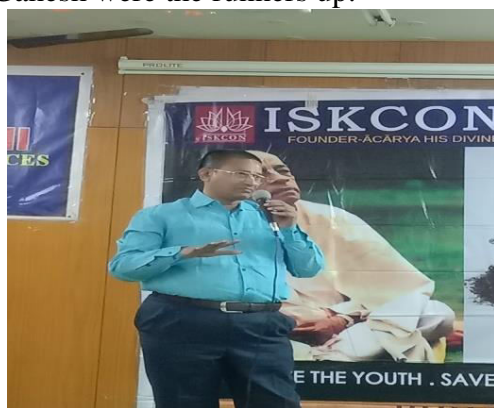


A rally led by our students, faculty and staff to show solidarity for our army brethren and for those whose lost their lives in the Pulwama Blast was organized by NSS.

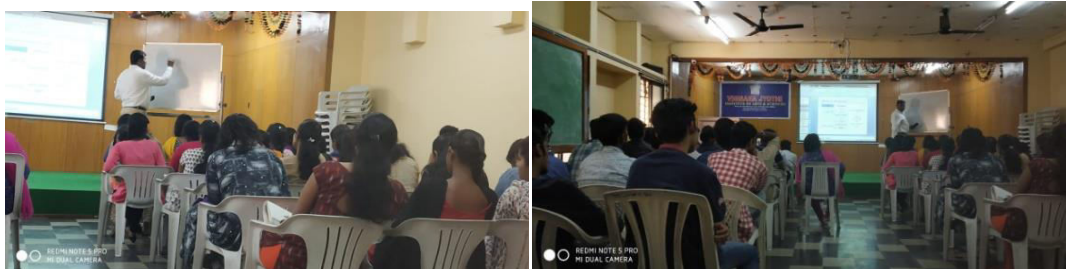
