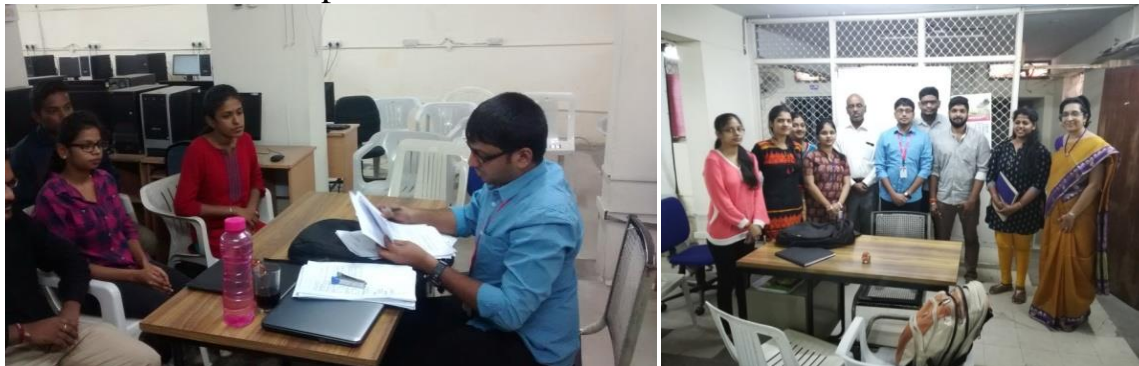

## PLACEMENTS:

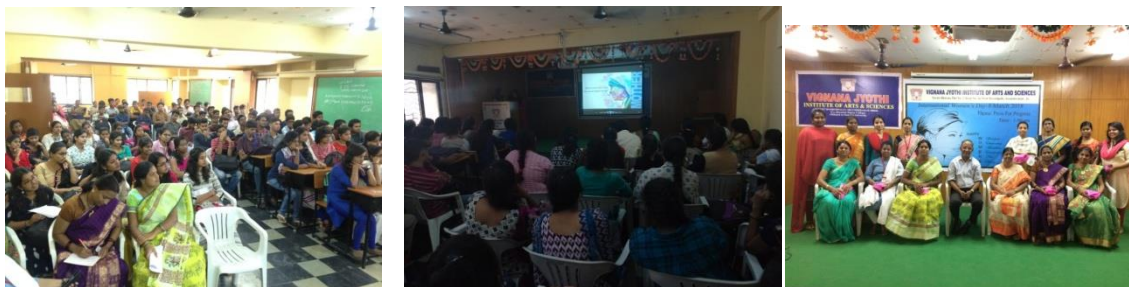

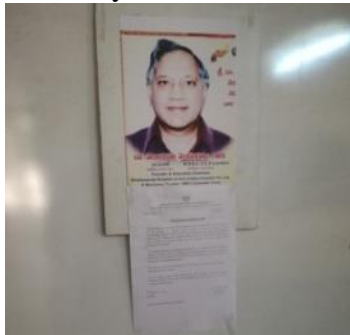
## News in brief:
