




Preliminary Round


Cultural Activities

A Letter addressed to Students

The frightening corona virus is playing havor the world over. Schools and colleges are the worst hit. We are writing this letter to you all particularly to focus on the need to go for vaccination.

- 1) The purpose of vaccination is to protect us against infection. Vaccination also protects people by providing 'herd immunity', if done on a large scale. The vaccine's power to prevent death or severe disease and ability to reduce transmission is already established through several studies. As there is the problem of demand and supply for vaccine, prioritisation of the groups for vaccination is going on. COVID-19 Vaccination for 18-plus age group is essential. How long can the schools and colleges remain closed? When the teachers and students are given vaccination on priority basis, they will be safe to attend offline classes. As the Government has opened up vaccination for all adults (18plus age), the college students and teachers should go for vaccination at the earliest.
- 2) There are some persons, even among the teachers and students, who suffer from vaccine hesitancy. This may be due to largely overblown reports of complications, fears based on inaccurate information or even due to lack of confidence. Disinformation is plenty on social media. But understand the benefit which is safety to life. Vaccine is the only safest medicine for COVID in the present-day context. In addition, having the mask, maintaining social distance, following hand-washing hygiene etc, are anyhow mandatory. A shot in the arm is the only safety mechanism at present. If all students and teachers take vaccine, institutions become a safe zone.
- 3) We implore all the teachers and students of VJIAS to register for vaccination immediately and take the shots as early as possible.
