- Kavya, B.Com final year won I prize in paper presentation competition



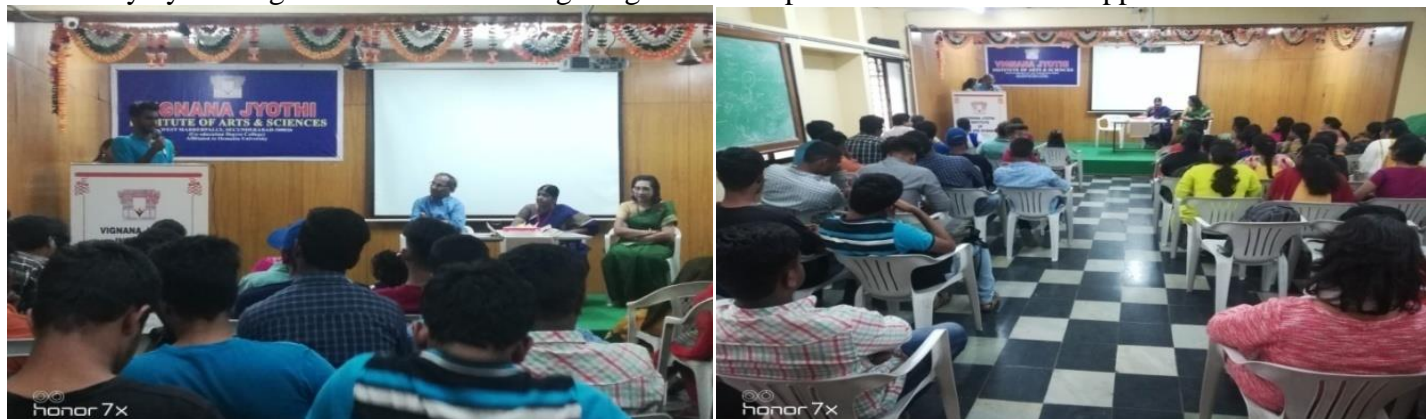
BATHUKAMMA CELEBRATIONS:

- Dr. N. Aruna, principal, was congratulated and felicitated by the director and the entire faculty on acquiring her Ph.D degree.

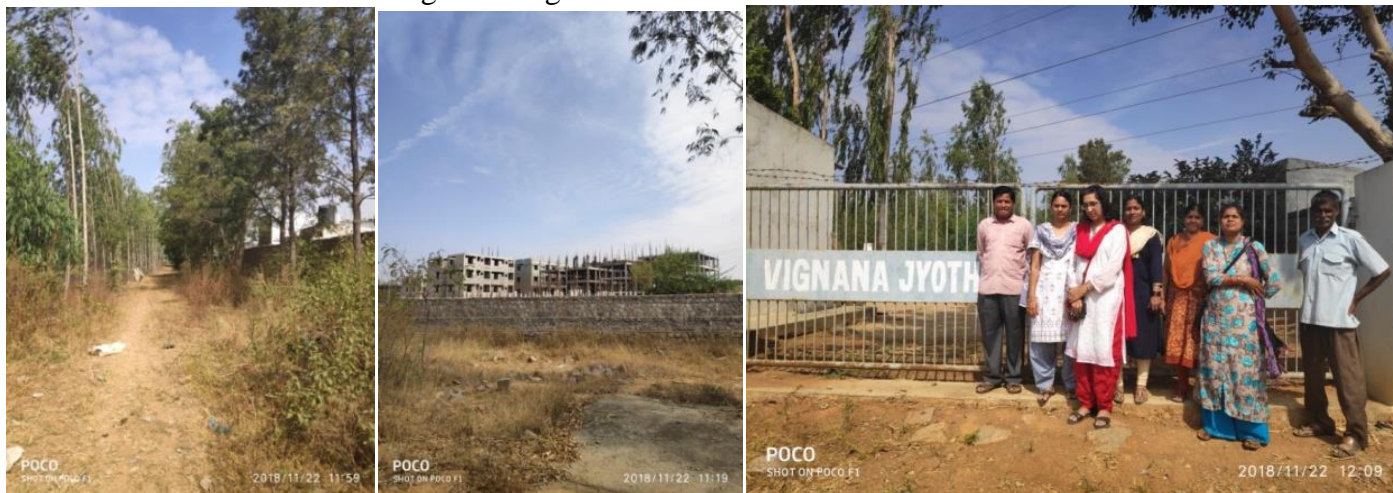

- Ms. T.Rama, Vice-Principal attended a workshop on "ELT Conclave" organized by The Hindu STEP.

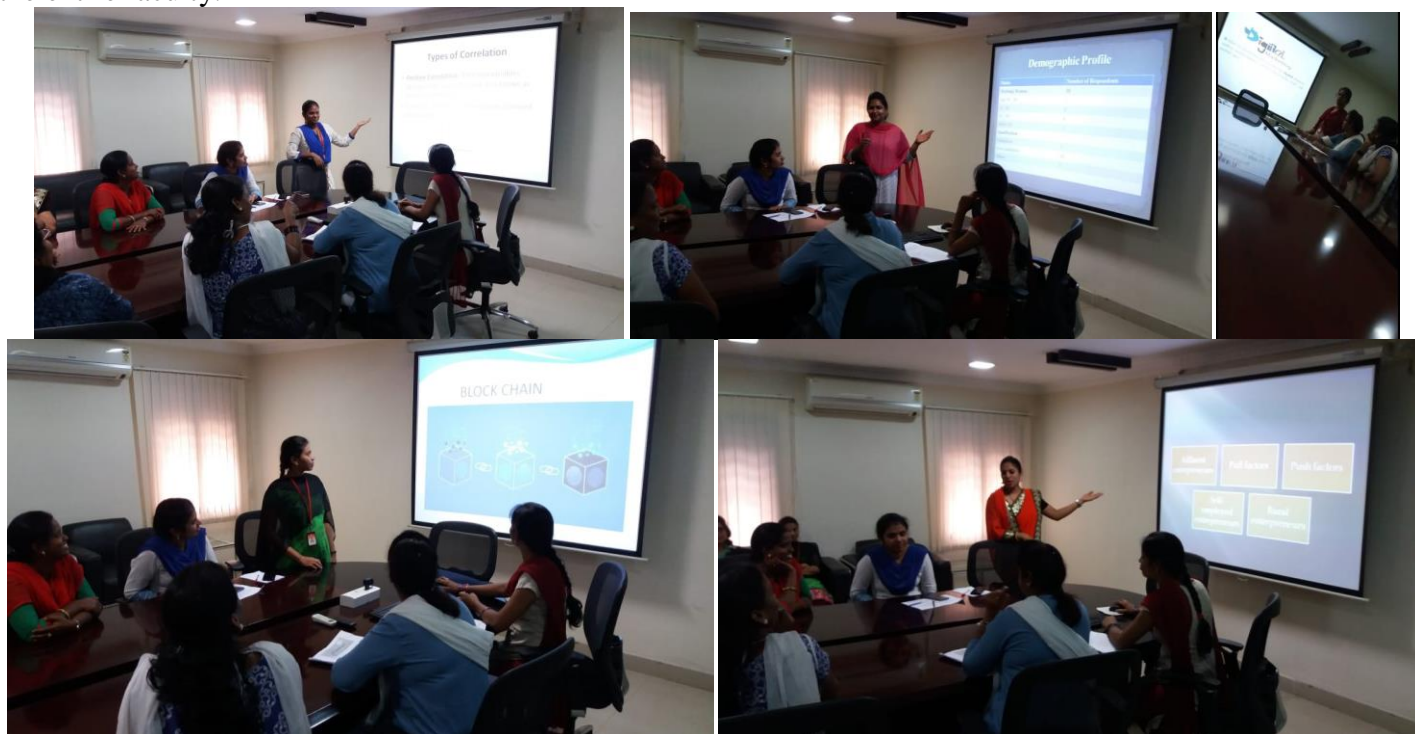


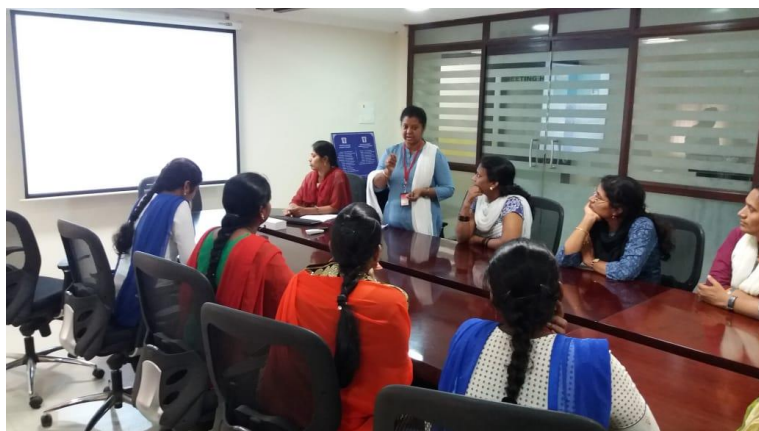
